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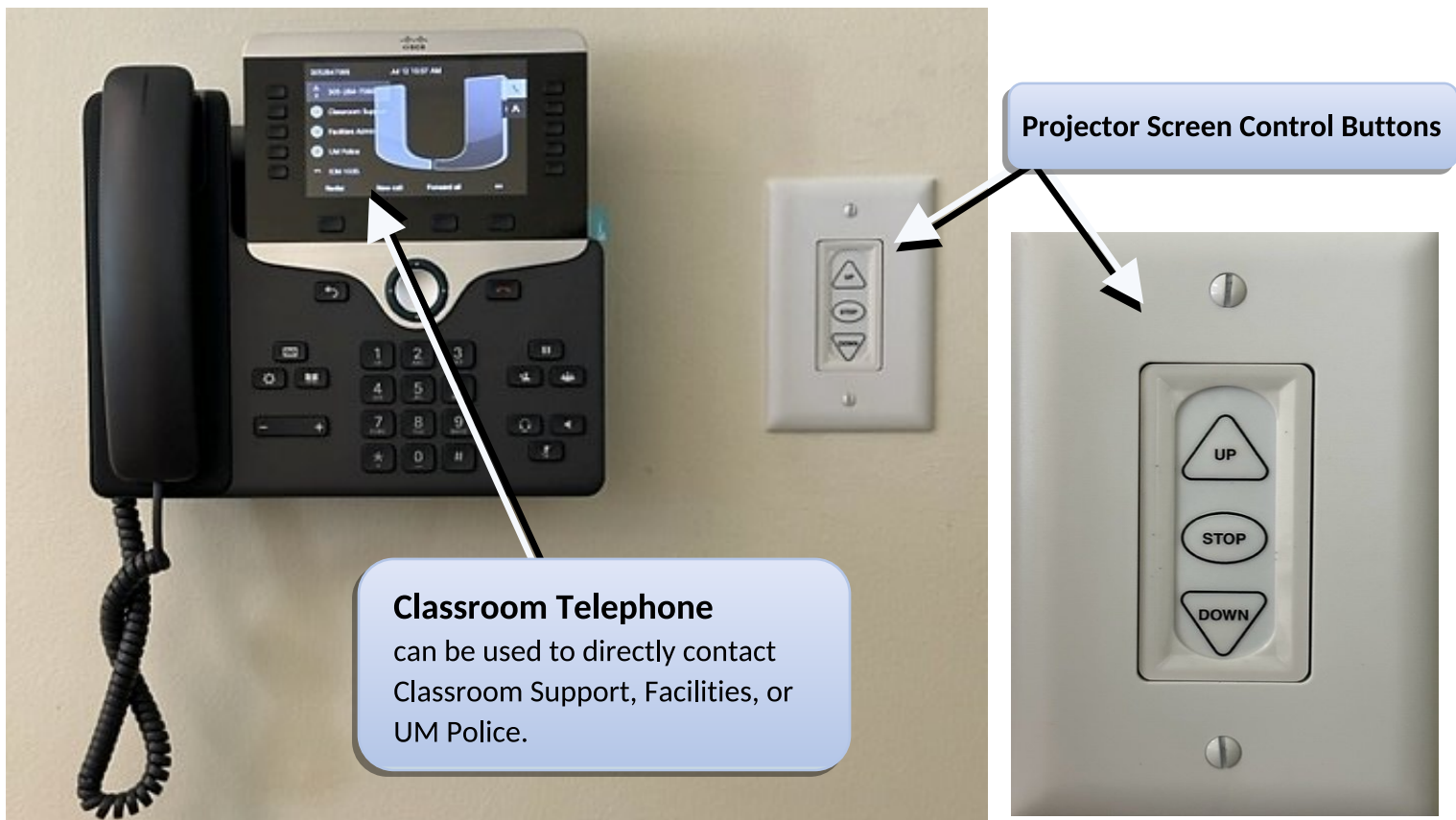
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Standard AV Set Up



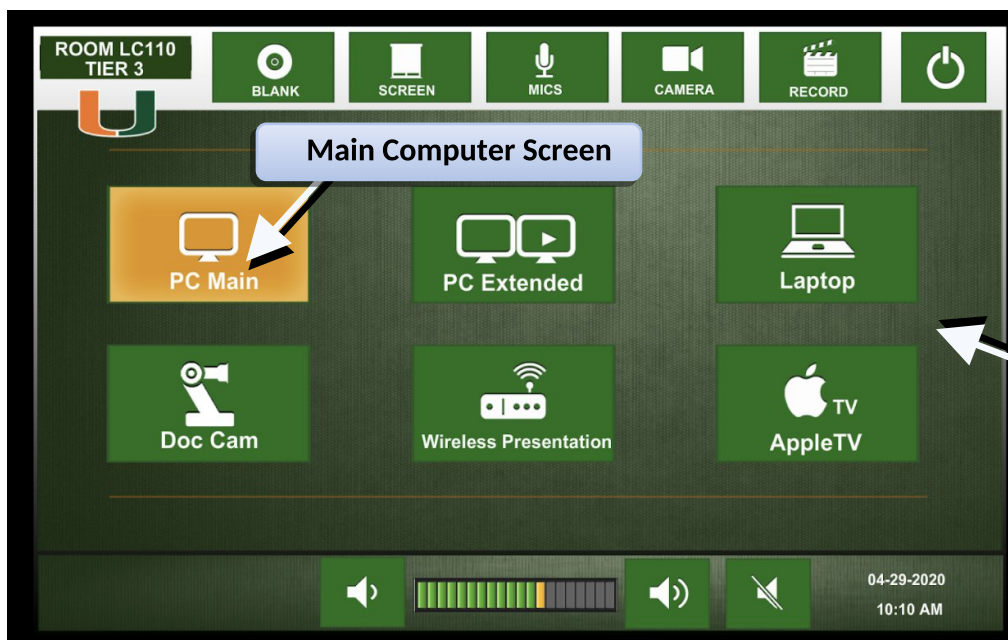
Some **touch panel systems** are motion sensor and will light up to display this screen.

Touch Panel

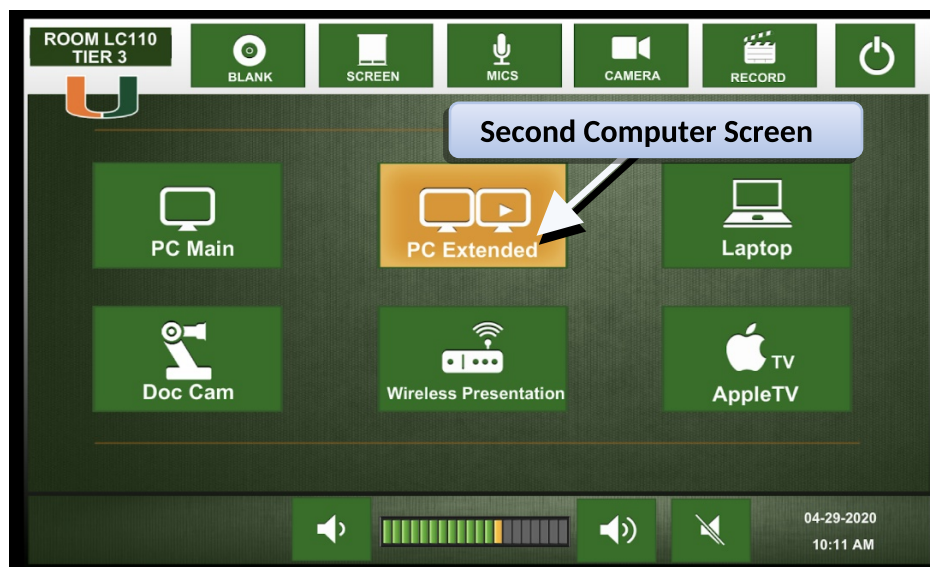
Tapping on the screen will start the **system power on**.

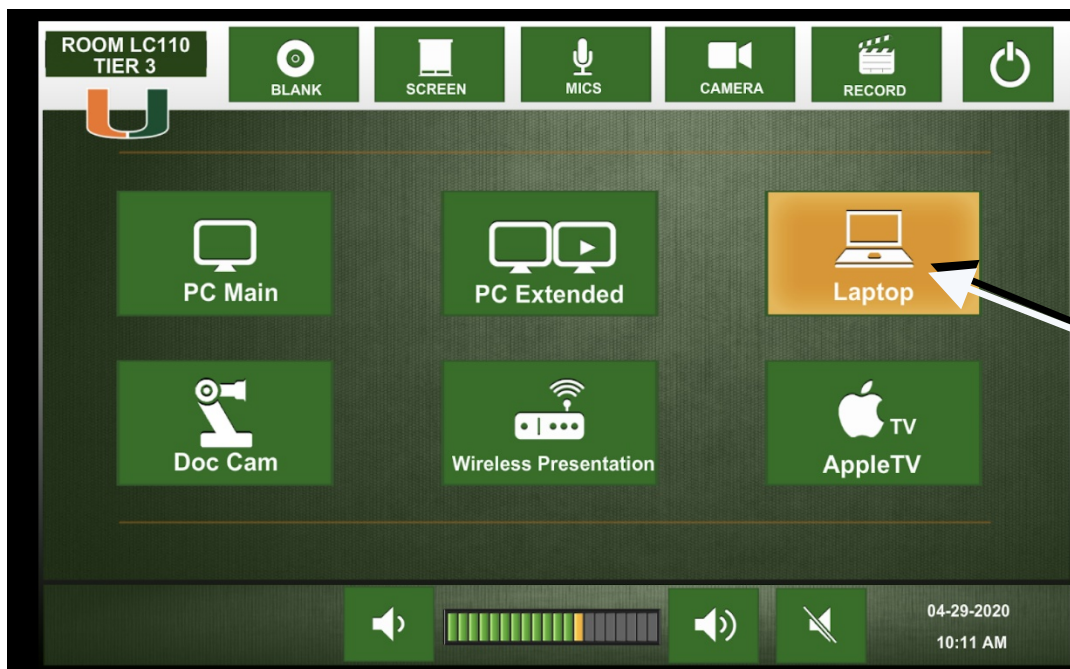


The touch panel has a variety of different projector display types.

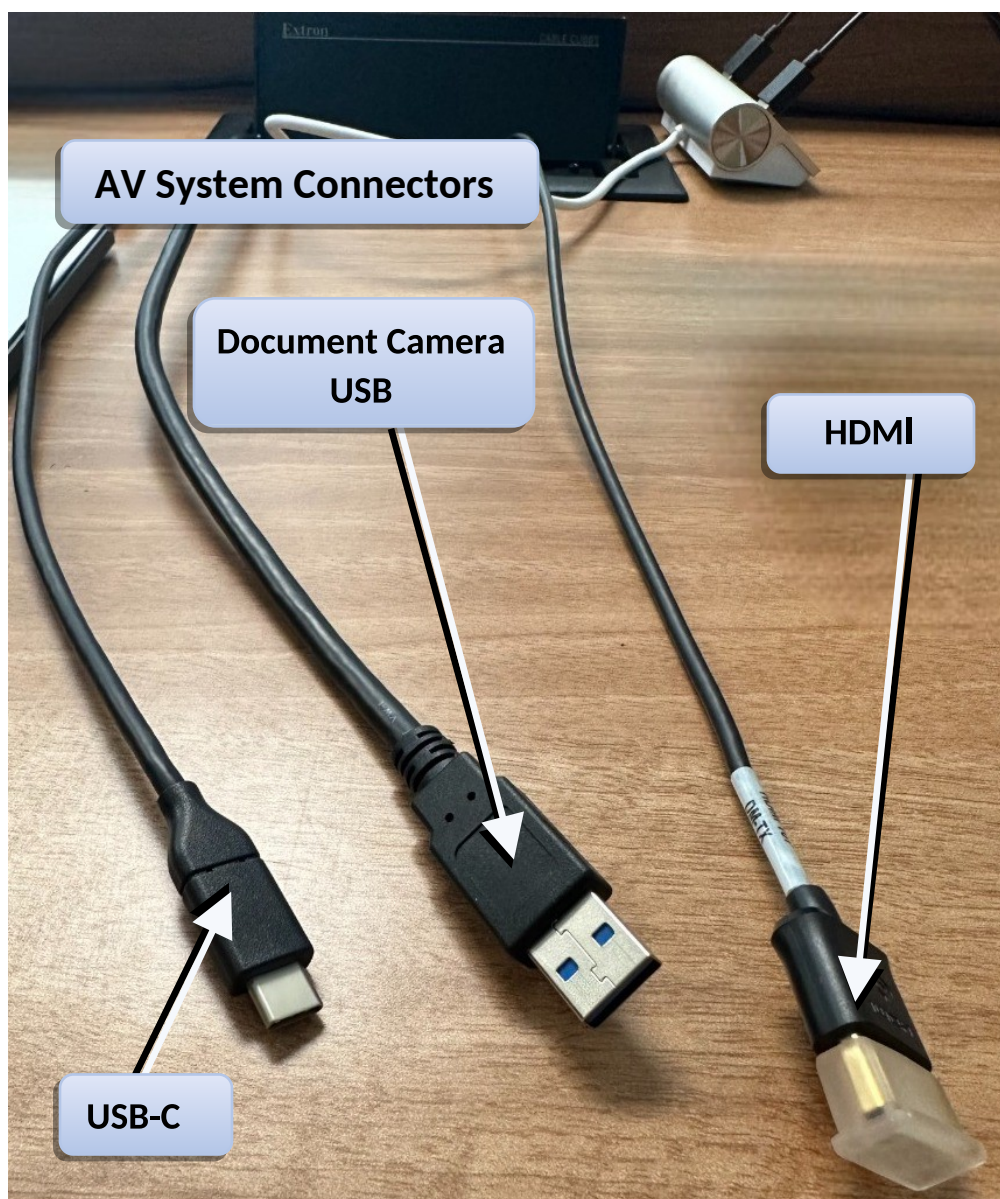


Tap on a specific icon to **activate the source** you would like to use.

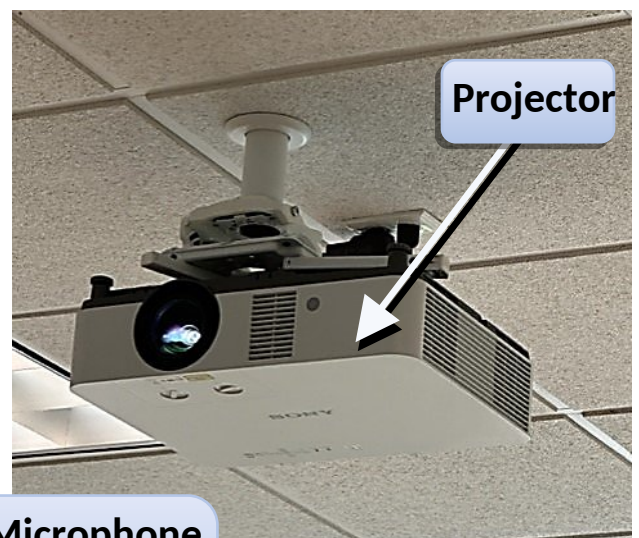
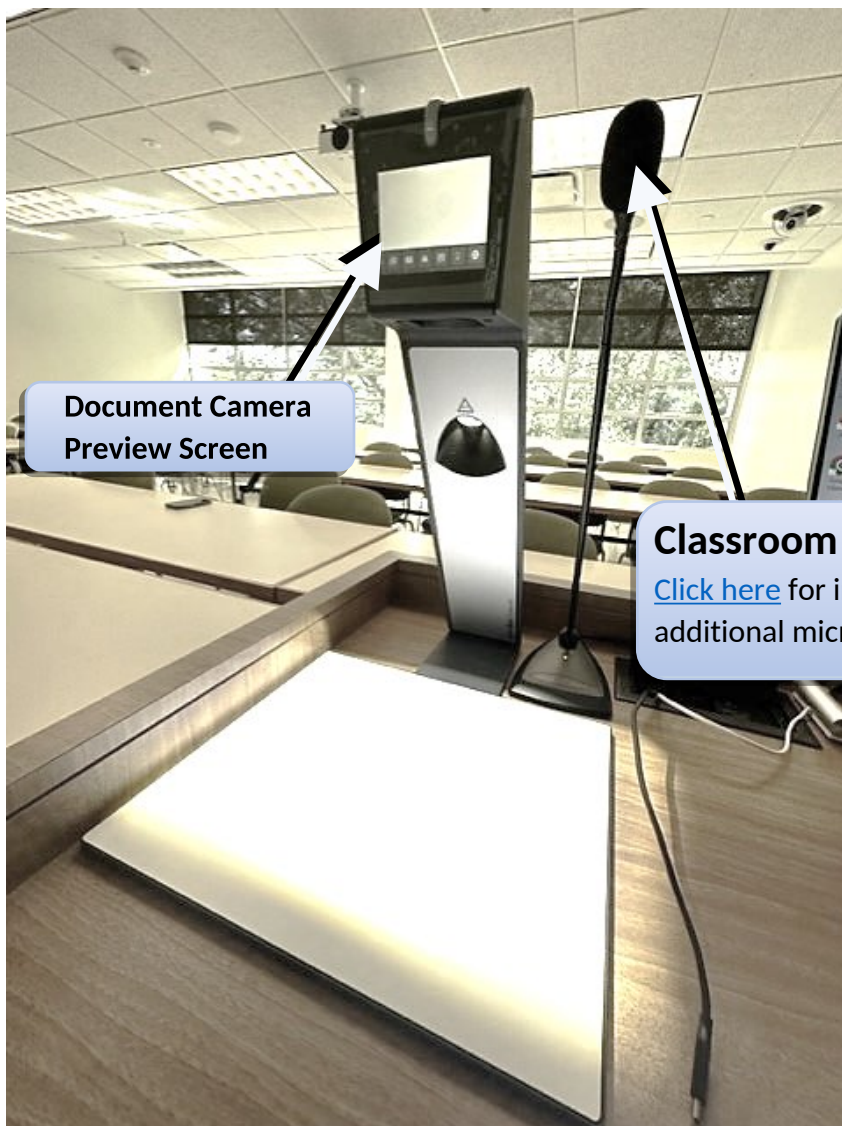
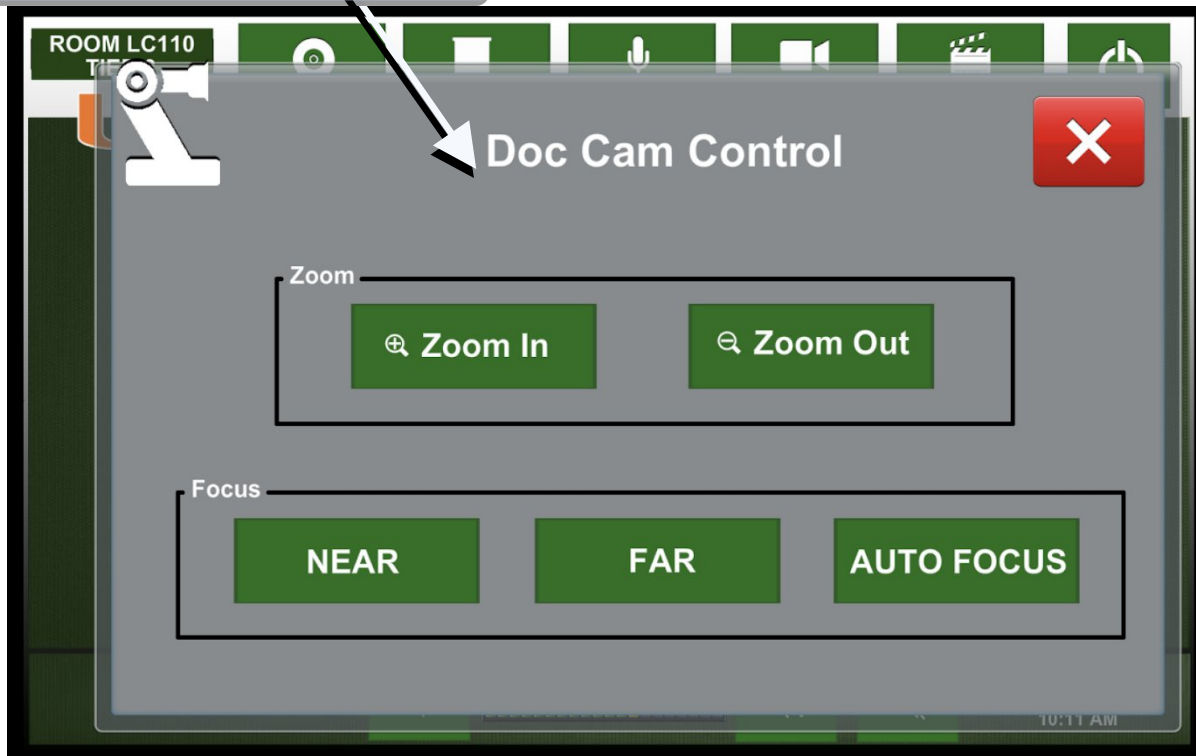




Tap this icon to connect a laptop and use the appropriate **AV System Connector**.

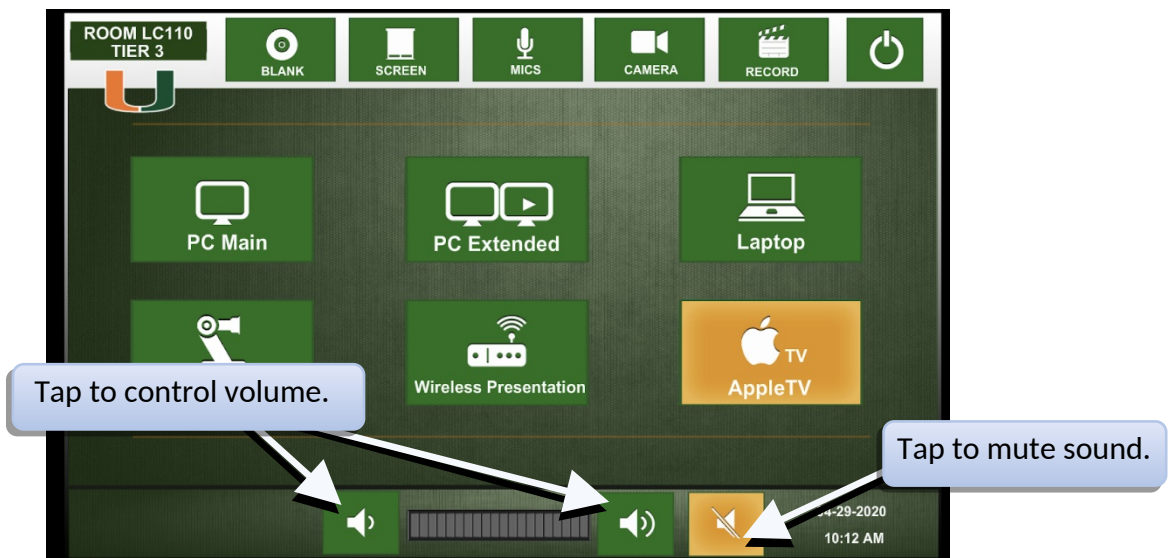
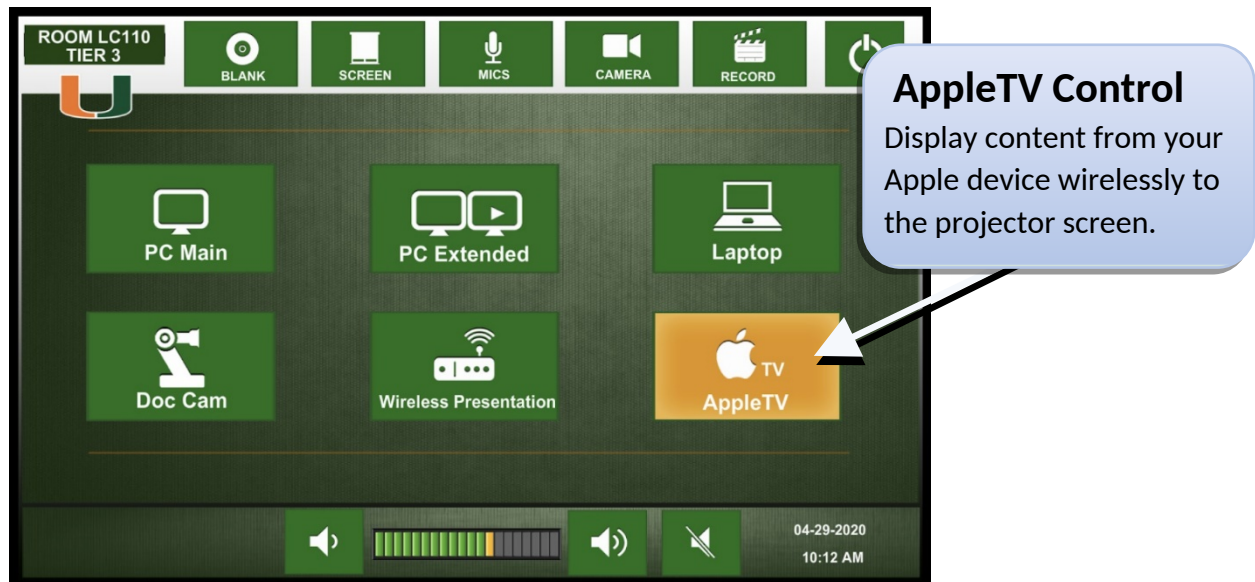
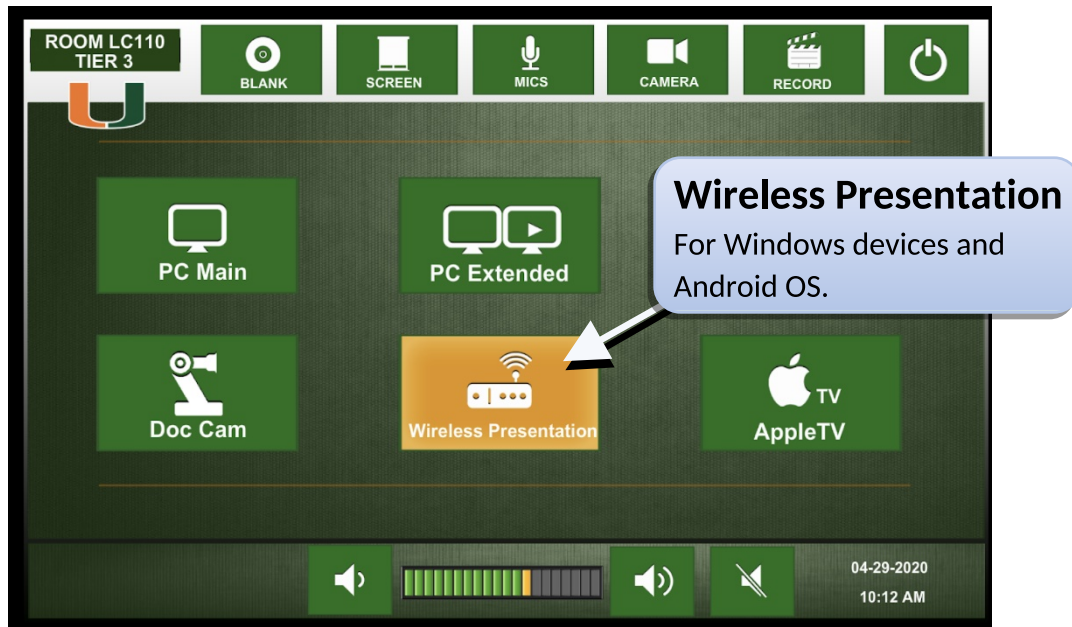

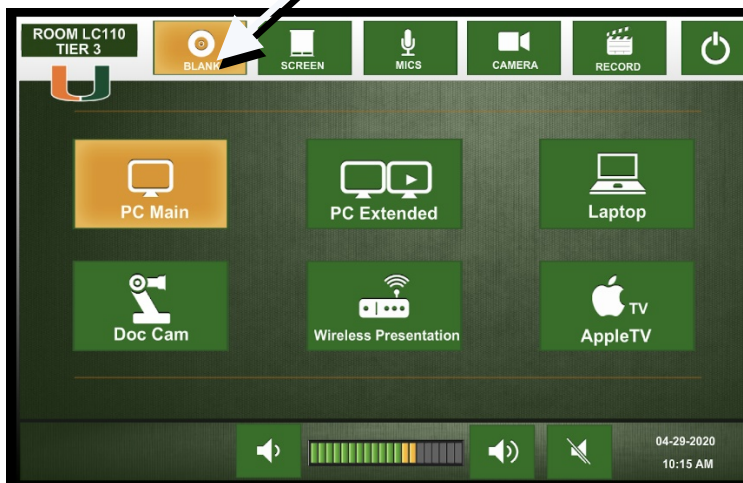


Classroom Microphone

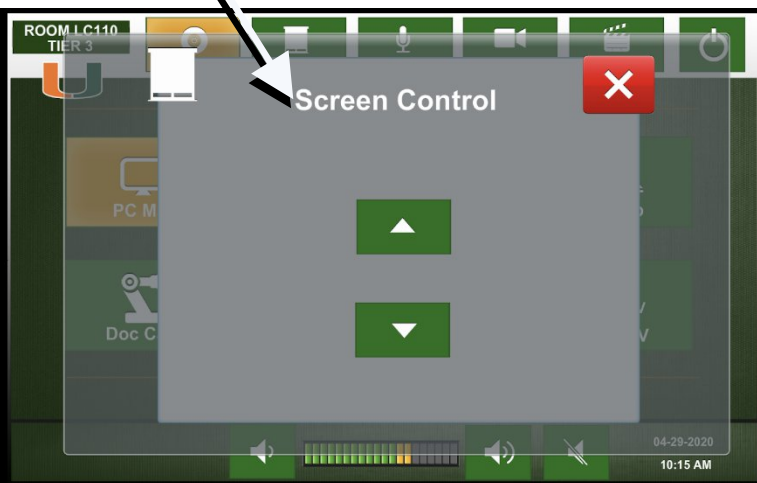

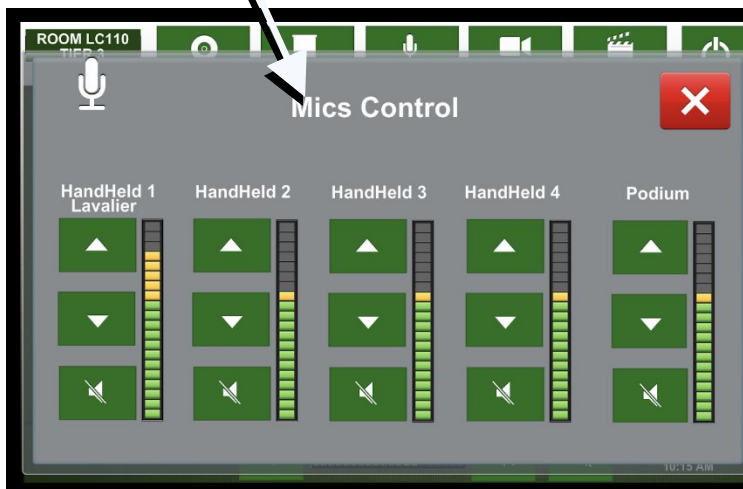
Tap **Blank** to create a blank screen, this stops the projector from showing what is on the computer.



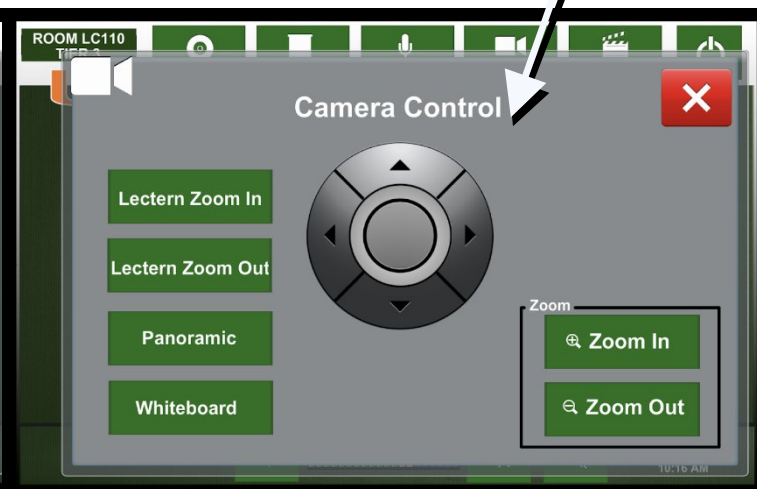
Tap **Screen** to open Screen Control.



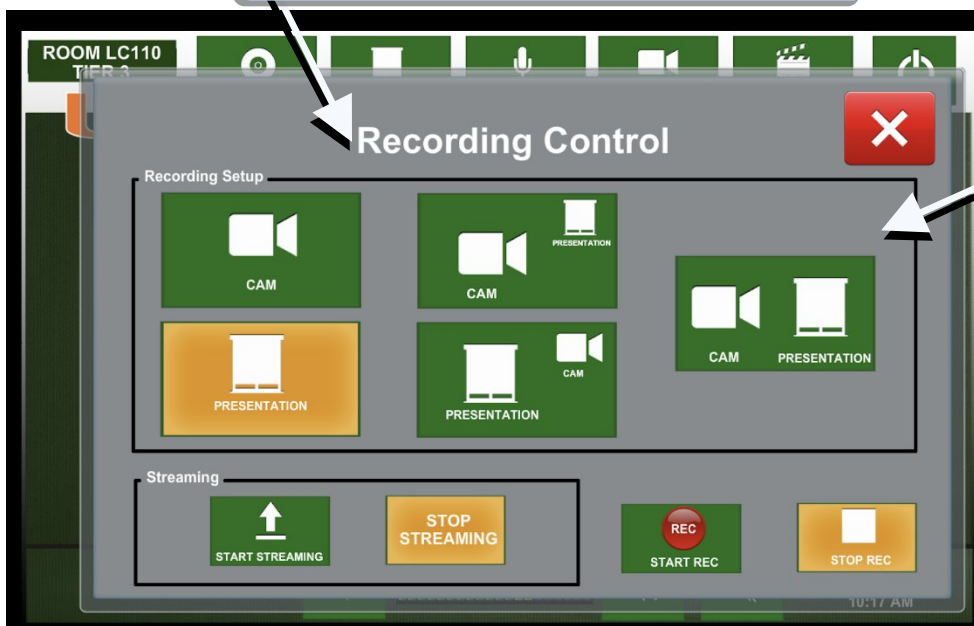
Tap **Mics** to open Mics Control.
